Jeff McHugh provided the following updates to Council:

<u>St Francis of Assisi, Christies Beach</u>: Trice (project management firm) prepared and submitted a proposed building and design process.

St Alban's Berri: Sale contract signed.

<u>St John the Baptist, Lameroo</u>: Auction scheduled for February 2024.

<u>King Charles the Martyr, Padthaway:</u> No movement from potential buyers for the property.

<u>Christ Church O'Halloran Hill</u>: Council (local government) will not allow subdivision or the required access that would facilitate selling off the unused Glebe land.

<u>Property Working Group:</u> The Group has been asked to consider:

- How might the Diocese fund unexpected unfunded liabilities?
- How can the Diocese use property to fund mission opportunities?
