St Francis of Assisi, Christies Beach: The formation of a Project Control Group has been approved to take the Christies Beach redevelopment through to Development Approval.

St Alban's Berri: Settlement completed on 14 March 2024.

King Charles the Martyr, Padthaway: Offers being pursued.

Property Working Group: Proposal of shared responsibility raised with Finance, Audit and Investments Committee, with a Plan to be ready to take formal proposal to Synod 2025.
