## **Blessing of a Home in Eastertide**

### The Celebrant begins with the following or some other greeting

Peace be to this house, and to all who dwell in it.

## Psalm 114 is then sung or said with one of the following antiphons:

Alternate 1

Antiphon Surrexit Dominus

Luke 24:34

Alleluia. The Lord is risen indeed:

Come let us adore him. Alleluia.

Antiphon Vidi aquam

Cf. Ezekiel 47:1,9

#### Psalm 114 In exitu Israel

When Israel came out of Egypt, \* the house of Jacob from a people of strange speech,

Judah became God's sanctuary \* and Israel his dominion.

The sea beheld it and fled; \* Jordan turned and went back.

The mountains skipped like rams, \* and the little hills like young sheep. What ailed you, O sea, that you fled? \* O Jordan, that you turned back? You mountains, that you skipped like rams? \* you little hills like young sheep?

Tremble, O earth, at the presence of the Lord, \* at the presence of the God of Jacob,

Who turned the hard rock into a pool of water \* and flint stone into a flowing spring.

now and for ever. Amen.

Book of Common Prayer (1979), Monday in Easter Week Almighty and Everlasting God, who in the Paschal mystery established the new covenant of reconciliation: Grant that all who have been reborn into the fellowship of Christ's Body may show forth in their lives what they profess by their faith; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.** 

Book of Common Prayer (1979), Thursday in Easter Week

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Let us pray.

### A period of silence may be kept.

Visit, O blessed Lord, this home with the gladness of your presence. Bless all who live here with the gift of your love; and grant that they may manifest your love [to each other and] to all whose lives they touch. May they grow in grace and in the knowledge and love of you; guide, comfort, and strengthen them; and preserve them in peace, O Jesus Christ, now and for ever. **Amen.** 

#### **Solemn Blessing** (Alternate 1)

May God the Father, who by Baptism adopts us as his children, grant you grace. **Amen.** May God the Son, who sanctified a home at Nazareth, fill you with love. **Amen.** 

May God the Holy Spirit, who has made the Church one family, keep you in peace. Amen.
And the blessing of God
Almighty, It the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be upon you and remain with you for ever.

# **Solemn Blessing** (Alternate 2)

May Almighty God, who has redeemed us and made us his children through the resurrection of his Son our Lord, bestow upon you the riches of his blessing. **Amen.** 

May God, who through the water of baptism has raised us from sin into newness of life, make you holy and worthy to be united with Christ for ever.

#### Amen.

May God, who has brought us out of bondage to sin into true and lasting freedom in the Redeemer, bring you to your eternal inheritance. Amen.
And the blessing of God Almighty, 4 the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be upon you and remain with you for ever.

Amen.

### The Celebrant then says to the people

The peace of the Lord be always with you.

And also with you.

Amen.
